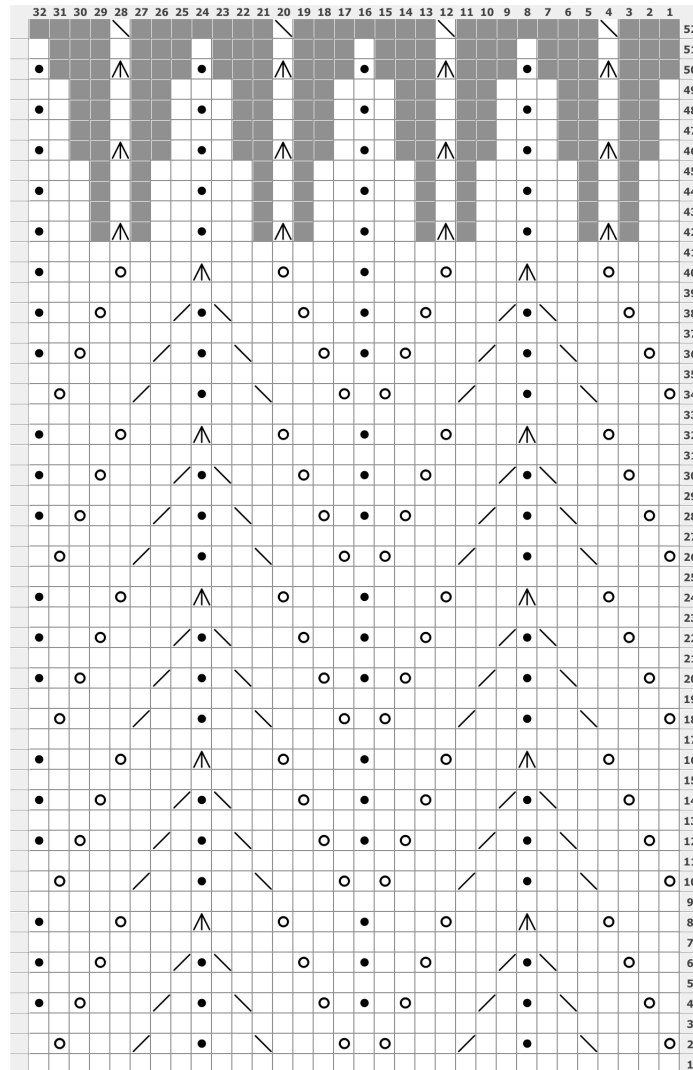


BLACK FOREST HAT

Black Forest Hat

Suggested Yarn: Noro Kureyon (#196 shown), more than one skein, approx. 130 yards.

Finished Size: 21.5" circumference, 8.5" deep

Gauge: 18 sts and 24 rows in 4" stockinette

Needles: 4.5mm/US #7 16" circulars, and set of same size dpns (or 1 40" Magic Loop.)

Cable cast on 96 Stitches. Join without twisting into round. Place marker. Follow chart or written instructions. Finish by threading yarn through the final loops. Weave in ends.

Round 1 & all odd numbered rounds: work even (knit)

Round 2: * yo, k3, ssk, k2, p1, k2, k2tog, k3, yo, k1 *

Round 4: * k1, yo, k3, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, k3, yo, k1, p1 *

Round 6: * k2, yo, k3, ssk, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, k2, p1 *

Round 8: * k3, yo, k3, central double decrease, k3, yo, k3, p1 *

Repeat this 8 round sequence to round 40, then begin **crowning** as follows:

Round 41 & all odd numbered rounds: work even (knit)

Round 42: * k2, central double decrease, k2, p1 *

Round 44: * k5, p1 *

Round 46: * k1, central double decrease, k1, p1 *

Round 48: * k3, p1 *

Round 50: * central double decrease, p1 *

Round 52: * ssk *

Legend:

knit
knit stitch

purl
purl stitch

ssk
Slip one stitch as if to knit, Slip another stitch as if to knit. Insert left-hand needle into front of these 2 stitches and knit them together

k2tog
Knit two stitches together as one stitch

Central Double Dec
Slip first and second stitches together as if to knit. Knit 1 stitch. Pass two slipped stitches over the knit stitch.
